



Modern Slavery Statement

This statement is made pursuant to Section 54, Part 6 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps the company has taken to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in our supply chains or in any part of our business. This statement applies to Total Polyfilm Group Limited and all its subsidiaries.

Total Polyfilm is a company engaged in the manufacture of polythene packaging products, together with the printing and converting of such products.

Modern slavery is a fundamental violation of human rights, which deprive a person of their liberty for someone else's commercial or personal gain. We have a zero tolerance approach to any form of modern slavery, and are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all of our business operations.

We expect the same high standards from all of our contractors, suppliers and other business partners. In addition, the same is also expected from any person working on the company's behalf, including employees at all levels.

Total Polyfilm has assessed the risk of human trafficking or slavery in our supply chain, and due to the business we are involved in, we believe it to be low.

Our relationship with suppliers prohibits forced or inhumane labour practices, Should it become apparent that any of our suppliers are using forced labour, or that their workers were subject to any form of compulsion, coercion or human trafficking we would expect that behaviour to be stopped with immediate effect.

Our HR department ensures that all prospective employees are legally entitled to work, and once employed are made aware of company policies. Our workplaces comply with all applicable laws and regulations, and our employees are safeguarded from abuse or coercion.
